BOOSTER PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction on the new Booster Pump Station began August 16, 2022. Site Preparation and some infrastructure piping was laid. The Site is all buttoned up for the Winter months, with construction set to resume in mid April 2023 with estimated completion by October of 2023. The District has secured **\$1,132,000.00** through the State Department of Water Resources for this much needed Project!
