We are excited to report that SPUD received an Amendment to its USFS Special Use Permit Authorization. The Amendment includes the new Booster Pump Station and the development of a Groundwater Well within the Special Use Area. As you may already be aware, the District received a Grant for the Booster Pump Station Project. Two additional Grants are to be presented for the Groundwater Well. The first through Prop 1, Round 3, already under review and the second to the Small Community Drought Relief Program, to be submitted within days. Both Grants are through the Department of Water Resources, (DWR).

# Per SPUD Water Ordinance Section 2.09 SHUTOFF VALVE ON THE CUSTOMER'S PROPERTY

SPUD Customers shall install, maintain, and use a customer's shutoff valve to turn water on and off for their convenience. Such valve shall be located downstream of the water meter. SPUD's valve shall not be used by the customer or the customer's representatives without the express written approval of SPUD. Unauthorized use constitutes tampering with the SPUD facilities. PLEASE BE SURE TO CALL AHEAD SHOULD YOU NEED ASSSITANCE WITH ANY SPUD FACILITIES OR SERVICES.
